Special Issue in *European Journal of Psychology Open*

Transforming Psychological Science in Europe and the World: Developments and Insights from the 19th European Congress of Psychology

The **European Journal of Psychology Open (EJPO)** as the official empirical journal of the European Federation of Psychologists' Associations EFPA, aims to highlight and promote empirical research in Europe, and feature the best current trends in the field.

Following up on previous European Congress of Psychology Special Issues, and in coordination with the organizers of the **19th European Congress of Psychology**, EJPO announces an open call for a Special Issue comprised of empirical papers by the speakers and participants in the Congress, scheduled to be published within 2025-2026. We aspire for rigorous and speedy peer review. The Special Issue will be edited by Professor Ioulia Papageorgi and Dr Eleni Karayianni, with the assistance of the EJPO editors.

We invite empirical papers in any area of psychology, following either quantitative or qualitative methodologies. Meta-analytic papers are also welcome. Papers that are descriptive of trends, or describe professional issues, are also relevant, as long as they are empirical.

We also welcome for this special issue, papers that would showcase the empirical aspects of the work of international, regional and national psychology bodies (such as EFPA committees and working groups or similar structures in other bodies): For example, surveys of psychologists, psychology associations or other samples, conducted to document a current problem or new development in the domain of the working group's scope of activities, descriptive statistics on an issue relevant to psychology that is part of outcome reports on the work, or the results of other types of small studies (quantitative or qualitative), conducted as part of the group's actions or dissemination activities.

As per the journal's policies, we also encourage submissions by early stage researchers and involvement of early stage researchers in the review and editorial process. Early career researchers who may have questions about the fit of their work for the journal, or who are interested in acting as reviewers for the journal are encouraged to contact the senior editor.
